

Apex High Band Student Behavior Contract

ALL STUDENTS must stay with a group/chaperone at all times.

You must listen to and respect ALL chaperones not just the one you've been assigned to.

Don't get off the bus without permission from Mr. Jarvis. For your safety, do not cross parking lots/streets unless instructed.

All STUDENTS must be in their own rooms (and remain in their rooms) by the stated curfew times on the itinerary. Leaving your room after curfew to get ice or a drink is not acceptable. Do that before curfew time. Lights out will be at the discretion of the band director. Keep in mind we will be on a schedule and you must be in "top" form to perform your best and enjoy the day. If an emergency occurs after curfew, call your chaperone.

There will be NO OPEN ROOM VISITATION. If you want to spend time with friends other than your roommates while at the hotel you must go to a common area.

Students are responsible for waking up on their own and eating breakfast on time. Call time/location in the mornings will be adjusted as needed.

No swimming or hot tubs.

No energy drinks like Monster and Red Bull. But, drink as much water as you like!

Refrain from purchasing large souvenirs as they may not be able to travel back home with us.

Lastly, and most importantly, HAVE FUN! We want this to be a fun experience for everyone, and as long as everyone follows the guidelines set forth here it should be.

Oh, one more thing.....All decisions of the Band Director are FINAL AND NOT OPEN FOR DISCUSSION.

We the undersigned agree to the policies and guidelines set forth by the Wake County Public School System (including but not limited to policies regarding behavior, weapons, illegal substances, clothing, respect for others, etc), the administration of Apex High School, and the Apex High School Band Director. We understand students can be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law in some cases. Parents, with your signature you understand that if your child breaks a rule, they can be sent home: you will be called by the director, asked for your credit card number, and your child will be sent home on the next flight to RDU. Since Wake County policy requires that they travel home with a chaperone, you will be required to also pay the chaperone's airfare home and the cost of their trip that they'll be missing out on.
