Other Info: Carpool! The Koka Booth Parking Lot is shared with local businesses and some will be leaving the park when you arrive. The gates open at 6:15. Booster Board Parents are the only parents that will be allowed in the gate before 6:15. Concessions are open if you'd like to purchase dinner, snacks or drinks. You are welcome to bring in picnics. **No alcoholic beverages and no smoking. This is a Wake County sponsored event.** Students are not allowed in the audience after 6:15. Once the kids arrive, they are not allowed to leave the Amphitheatre. Bring a lawn chair or a blanket. You may rent a chair for \$5. Rain will not stop the event. The event will only be canceled if there is lightning. Umbrellas and tents are not allowed.
