

Apex High School Band Boosters Minutes from September 9, 2014

Meeting called to order at 7:05 pm

Mattress Sale Fundraiser Information- Clint from Mattress fundraiser

Sale Date: October 11, 2014. Apex High Cafeteria. 10 am-5pm.

1 in 10 people are in the market for a mattress. There are a lot of mattress stores in our area-indicating high demand for mattresses at any given time.

The mattresses sold through the fundraiser can be sold less expensively than stores due to:

- 1. No overhead
- 2. No advertising fees

Lower end mattresses save about 30% off retail.

Upper end mattresses save about 50% off retail.

Prices begin at \$199. Brands include Resonic, Simmons Beautyrest, Southerland. Prices include box spring. All sizes are available, and some mattresses can even be cut to size for unusual size and antique beds.

Every band family will try to find one person who is in the market for a mattress. 85-90% of their sales come from personal referrals.

On the day of the sale, there will be 24 beds set up in the AHS cafeteria from 10am-5pm. Clint brings a sales team with him. Students will be there to create a festive atmosphere, wear the mattress costume, etc. They will work in shifts with about 20 students per shift. Pizza will be provided. Mattresses are delivered by the company 2 weeks later for \$50, and can they can remove old mattresses for a fee of \$25.

Mattresses can be paid by cash, credit, check, or even layaway.

Many other bands in our area have had sales. All of them raised more than \$3000, and some over \$6000.

No one "guilt purchases" a mattress, so you can repeat the sale each year and it will be a different 10% each year, so it is a win-win for the band and the community.

Each student will receive flyers where they will add their name. If their customers buy a mattress, the student receives \$25 into their band account for the 1st mattress sold, and \$50 for the second. The general band fund receives \$50 for each twin mattress sold, \$75 for each full or queen, and \$100 for each king.

There are also bonuses for multiple mattresses sold.

We have signs that can go in yards for those who are willing (sign on the clipboard.)

We may need to schedule a Monday or a Friday rehearsal in the next few weeks.

Drill learning is going slowly. They talk during breaks, and they seem to take a long time to actually learn the drill.

Spring Break Trip-Walt Disney World. Exact dates TBA. The cost will run approximately \$700. We will most likely leave the Friday evening that school gets out, and drive through the night. We will have Saturday, Sunday, and Monday at the parks returning Tuesday or Wednesday. We will have a parade one of the days and a music clinic the other day that lasts about 2 or 3 hours with a Disney musician. They also have a Visual Ensemble clinic as well.
