Disney Trip

Please see Disney PDF for complete information. Price is \$800 based on 132 students and 16 chaperones. We will have an 8:1 ratio of students to chaperones. Students will need to bring \$ for souvenirs and meals on the way. Band fees must be paid in full before a student is allowed to go on the trip. Price includes 3 days in Disney parks. (Magic Kingdom, EPCOT, and Hollywood Studios)

Payment of \$800 is broken into 4 payments- one per month.

Students will check in with their chaperone at various times during the day. Kids MUST ride the bus to the hotel with their chaperone. This is the only way to ensure that everyone is accounted for.

Concert band students can go on the Disney trip. They will be fitted for a uniform and they will march in the parade.
