How We Will Meet

- If the performers are visiting the Magic Kingdom, we can meet in the park and your vehicle will bring equipment and uniforms to the Preshow Area, where the performers prepare. Or, you can choose to arrive directly to the Preshow Area on your busses. *Personal vehicles are not permitted. Disney guest transportation does not go to this area.*

- We'll meet you 1½ hours prior to performance time, or if you choose to arrive on your busses with performers in uniform or costume, we can meet 1 hour prior.
- Event participants must arrive together.
- Friends and family of event participants are not permitted in the Preshow Area.

Dress Code

If you have performed at Magic Kingdom Park before, please read:

Worldwide, Disney theme parks are amongst the most sought after locations for marching bands to perform. As such, we want you and your band presented at your very best!

Our new standard of dress for staff members marching with their band is the same as if your band was performing in any of the nationally televised holiday parades:

- Required attire for male staff – dress shoes, slacks, dress shirt, jacket and tie
- No longer approved – khakis, jeans, shorts, t-shirts, polo/golf shirts, athletic shoes
- Required attire for female staff – comfortable dress shoes, slacks/skirt, dress shirt, or a business dress
- No longer approved – khakis, jeans, Capri pants, shorts, t-shirts, polo/golf shirts, tank tops, mini-skirts, sun dresses, flip flops

Banner carriers not dressed in a band uniform must adhere to these guidelines.

ALL staff members who plan to march with the band will need to be dressed according to the guidelines above. This includes percussion instructors, guard instructors and any other adults marching with the band.

- Contact us if you want to make changes to the uniforms or costumes we've approved for this performance.
- Due to copyright restrictions, we don't allow mascots, portrayals of movie, television, and animated characters, or of people whose images have been copyrighted.

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March Guidelines

- Let us know if you have participants 7 to 10 years old when we speak to you by phone, so we can make special arrangements for them.
- Plan to step-off playing. Your audience will be able to hear and see the band as soon as they make their entrance. The band should play the entire route but brief cadences are OK.
- Instrumentalists are to march no more than 6 across in ranks.
- If you have an auxiliary, they must adhere to our *Auxiliary Performance and Safety Regulations*.

- The band must maintain a continuous "forward march" with no stops or choreographed march steps.

How We Will Meet

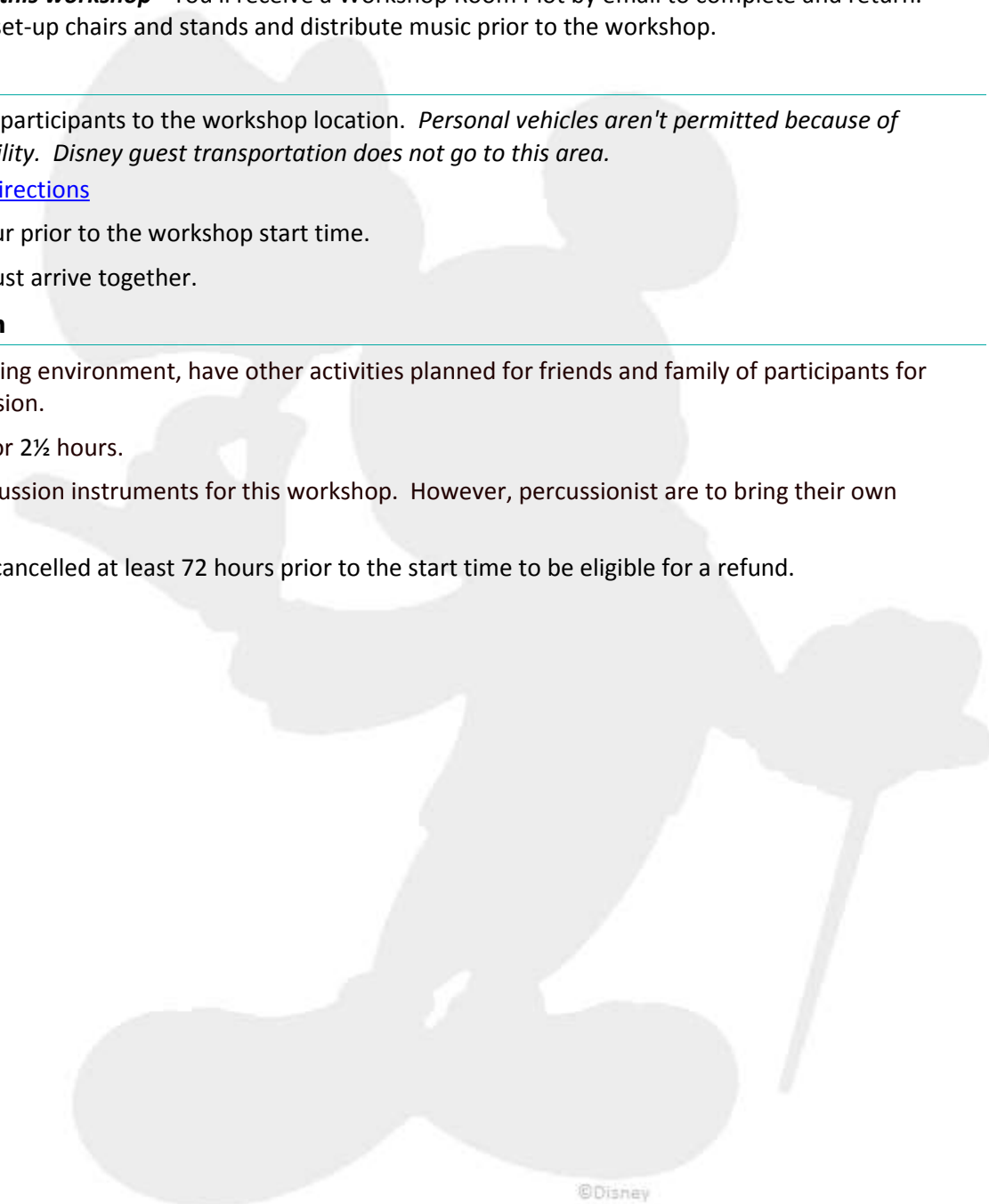
- Your busses will take participants to the workshop location. *Personal vehicles aren't permitted because of limited parking availability. Disney guest transportation does not go to this area.*
